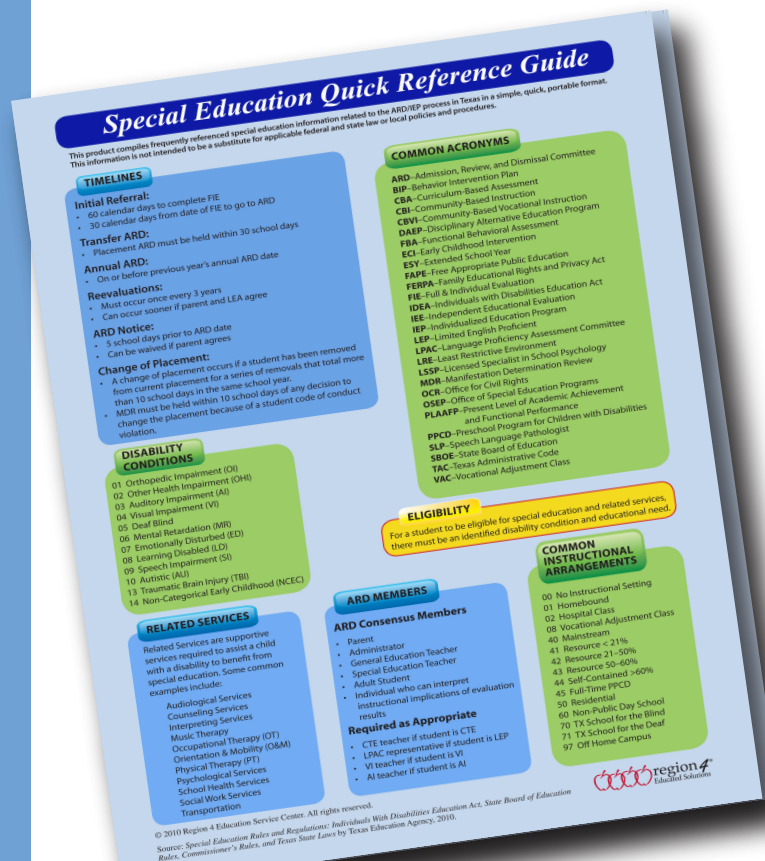
Use as a *staff development tool* for teachers, counselors, diagnosticians, speech pathologists, and related services personnel.
