Re: Required School Board Training – Evaluating and Improving Student Outcomes (EISO) and Orientation to the Texas Education Code (OTEC)

Evaluating and Improving Student Outcomes (EISO) school board training was required by passage of Senate Bill (SB) 1566 in the 85th Texas Legislature in 2017. The statute requires "a trustee to complete at least three hours of training every two years on evaluating student academic performance." This training is also required of newly elected trustees within their first 120 days (4 months) of service. Likewise, Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Title 19, Part 2, Chapter 61, Rule §61.1 requires new trustees to complete the *Orientation to the Texas Education Code (OTEC)* within their first year in office.

To assist trustees with meeting these essential training requirements, Region 4 is pleased to offer various training opportunities. Details for each session are included ion the following page. The cost of the in-person sessions are \$90 per participant with lunch or dinner included. The on-demand session is \$100 per participant. To register, visit www.esc4.net, select "Professional Development", and enter the Session ID number listed for the desired session or use the link in the chart. *Please note that the state rule precludes EISO sessions from being provided in an online or virtual format, so all sessions are in-person.*

The EISO training requirement can also be met through a qualified Team of Eight training session offered by Region 4. The Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) has informed us that they will also offer an EISO session during their Summer Leadership Institute (SLI) sessions in June. 




